- ❖ The Thesis has to be graded “**A**” (or equivalent).
- ❖ This application is open to all **master theses** of universities. Hence, no bachelor or PhD theses are accepted.
- ❖ The length of the published version of the thesis has to be **below 200.000 characters** (incl footnotes etc). Thus, also parts of a longer thesis may be submitted.
- ❖ The thesis submitted has to comply with the **stylesheet of the ICL Journal** which can be downloaded at http://www.icl-journal.com/submissions_contact.
